Green = Lanu Meamata

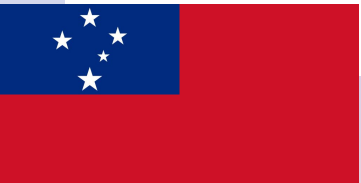
Gold = Lanu Auro

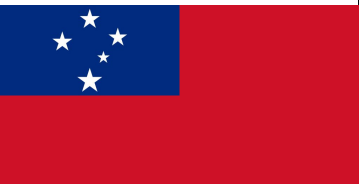
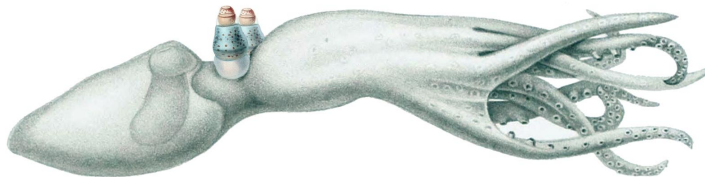
The White is said to represent Purity

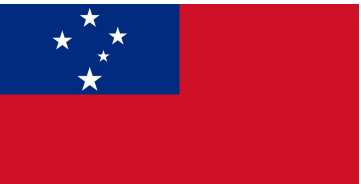
